## Who is eaf?

The eaf is the umbrella association of protestant institutions and organisations for matters concerning family policy at national and Laender level.

The eaf sees itself as a professional interdisciplinary network for family related issues.

## What is eaf's mission?

To examine from a professional perspective the development of the general conditions for families in society.

To establish that the needs and concerns of families are part of social policy discussions.

## What are eaf's goals?

A family and children friendly infrastructure, emphasising the development of care and education for children aged 0 - 12.

Stronger financial support for families.

Equal opportunities for men and women in all areas of life.

The recognition of every kind of family form and structure.

The support of families in situations of crisis and conflict.

## How does eaf work?

It is advised by highly professional committees whose members work in a voluntary capacity.

It formulates proposals on specific topics of family policy, e.g. social protection systems.

It introduces statements and proposals to political and church committees and associations at national and Laender level, either in the context of pending legislative projects or independently.

It works on the basis of the "Family Policy Agenda" (Familienpolitische Leitlinien) which is updated regularly.

It publishes the "Family Policy Information" (Familienpolitische Informationen) and a newsletter. News updates are available on the website.

It networks with its member associations, other family associations as well as the administrative office of the Protestant Church in Germany (EKD).

It hosts conferences and symposia on current topics.
